Georgina Town Council May 4

Treasure Hill Park development within registered plan of subdivision

Council received the report and approved the recommendation for the design of the park in the Treasure Hill subdivision, located north of Church Street across from Natanya Boulevard. The subdivision is 50 per cent built out, and park design and development should move forward. Council approved an additional recommendation that Recreation Division staff engage the Georgina Accessibility Advisory Committee in the final design and equipment for the park. Council also approved a 10 per cent contingency for the park project to address accessibility and other components.

Award of contract – selective resurfacing and asphalt maintenance

Council received the report and approved the recommendation to award the contract for selective resurfacing and asphalt maintenance to Lisbon Paving Co. Ltd. The use of selective resurfacing as part of the maintenance and repair program provides an opportunity to extend the lifecycle of a road by repairing localized sections that have failed, potentially prior to other adjacent sections not needing repair. The list of roads anticipated for work includes Wexford Drive, Deer Park Drive and North Street, among others. 2021-2022 Windrow Snow Clearing Program update

Council received the report on the Windrow Snow Clearing Program update and approved the recommendation to provide this service to residents for the 2022/23 winter season. The application window will open mid-august, and will be limited to the first 500 applications. Council directed staff to include a new operating initiative in the 2023 budget to include the Windrow Snow Clearing Program as an annual program beginning in 2023/2024.
