Town commences legal action surrounding Pefferlaw Fire Hall

Georgina, ON - Effective today, the Town has terminated its contract with BECC Construction Group Ltd. in connection with the construction of the Pefferlaw Fire Station. In the near future, the Town will be retaining the services of another contractor to complete the construction project. Once retained, that new contractor will establish a completion date for the Pefferlaw Fire Station.

“This project is important to Pefferlaw residents, this Council, and our community as a whole. Taking these steps allows us to move this project forward, bringing to fruition the building that we all had envisioned. We remain committed to completing Pefferlaw Fire Station 1-8, which will allow Georgina Fire and Rescue Services to continue to provide a high level of service for residents, businesses and visitors,” said Mayor Margaret Quirk.

Legal action will be commenced shortly by the Town against BECC Construction Group Ltd. and against Echelon Insurance, the issuer of a Performance Bond in favor of the Town, in which the Town will be seeking payment from those parties of all cost overruns and delay costs incurred in the construction of the Pefferlaw Fire Station.

Georgina Fire will continue to provide service from the temporary facility in Pefferlaw.
