Town to reopen some facilities

Georgina, ON – The Town of Georgina is in Step 3 of the Province of Ontario's Roadmap to Reopen, which came into effect on July 16. As vaccination rates continue to rise and COVID-19 cases drop, the Town is now reopening some facilities for public use. Public health and workplace safety measures will continue to apply, including maintaining physical distance, capacity limits, and wearing face coverings in indoor spaces and whenever physical distancing is a challenge.
