BY-LAW NUMBER 2017-0024 (PWO-2)

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NUMBER 2004-0078 (PWO-2), A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE INSTALLATION OF ENTRANCES FROM ROADWAYS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE TOWN OF GEORGINA


WHEREAS Section 7 of By-law Number 2004-0078 (PWO-2) authorizes the Town of Georgina to perform the installation of culverts for new entrances;


AND WHEREAS Policy RD-7 has been altered to reflect a change of the standard type and material specifications for culverts and has set out that all costs associated with all new entrance culverts and resident-requested culvert alterations to be the responsibility of the applicant;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GEORGINA THAT Section 7 of By-law No. 2004-0078 (PWO-2) be amended as follows;

7. In the case of new entrances where an entrance culvert is required or in the case of widening, altering or relocation of an existing entrance, a culvert shall be provided by the applicant and the work shall be carried out by, and at the expense of, the applicant, which shall be subject to the approval of the Director of Operations and Infrastructure, or his/her designate. In no case shall the culvert be less than 6 metres or more than 9 metres, and all items must meet current Town standards.
