- i) Any person may attend the meeting and/or make written or verbal representation in consideration of the proposed Official Plan Amendments and Zoning By-law Amendment. Written comments should be mailed/ emailed to the Planning Division as noted above. Please include your name and address so you may be contacted if necessary.
- ii) If a person or public body would otherwise have an ability to appeal the decision of the Town of Georgina to the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal but the person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the Town of Georgina before the proposed Official Plan Amendments or amending Zoning By-law is passed, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decisions.
- iii) If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the Town of Georgina before the proposed Official Plan Amendments are adopted, or before the amending Zoning By-law is passed, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision of the approval authority to the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal.
- iv) If a person or public body does not make oral submission at a public meeting or make written submission to the Town of Georgina before the proposed Official Plan Amendments are adopted, or before the amending Zoning By-law is passed, the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal unless, in the opinion of the Tribunal, there are reasonable grounds to do so.
