

Major Streets - application

These are streets with generally less pedestrian traffic and with higher vehicular volumes and speeds, outside BIA areas.




Example: Metro Road South at Simcoe Ave, Keswick






Major Streets - design details

These are streets within BIA areas with store fronts, heavy pedestrian traffic, and frequent destination arrivals.



Example: The Queensway at Simcoe Ave, Keswick














Special Streets - design details

These quiet streets are typically along identified cycling routes with ample landscaped features.




