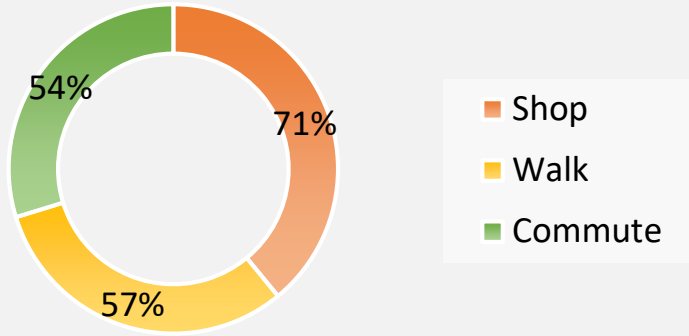

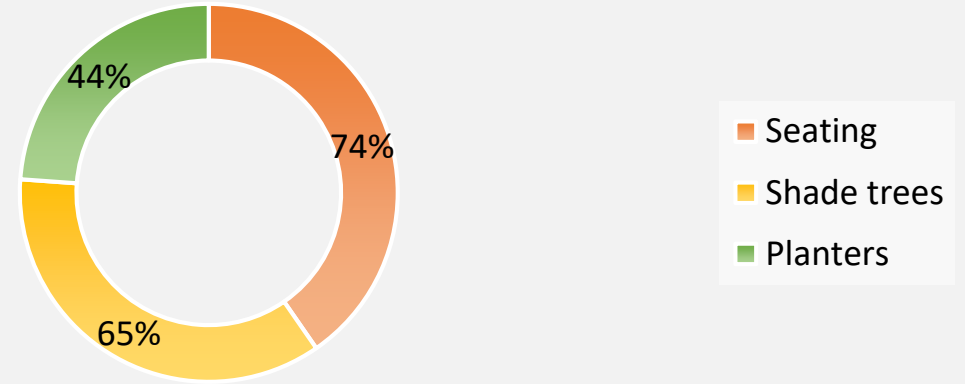

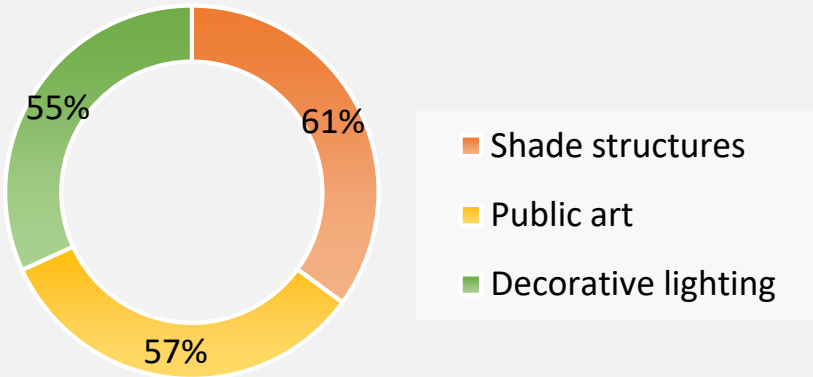
Q2: HOW DO YOU USE THESE STREETS?



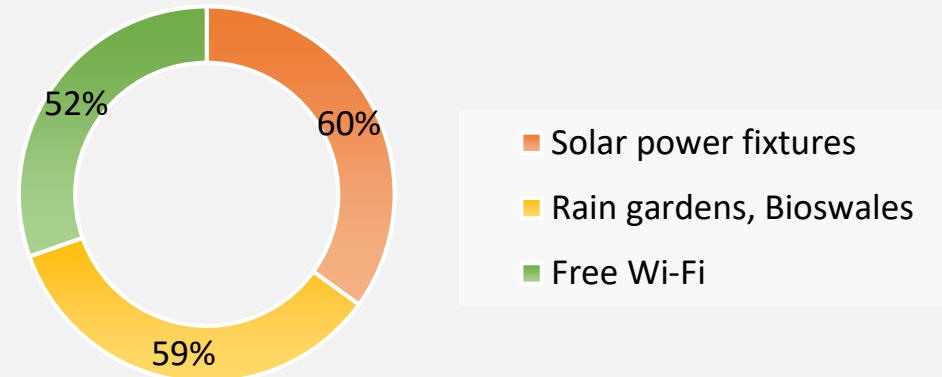
Q3: WHAT FUNCTIONAL AMENITIES ARE MISSING?

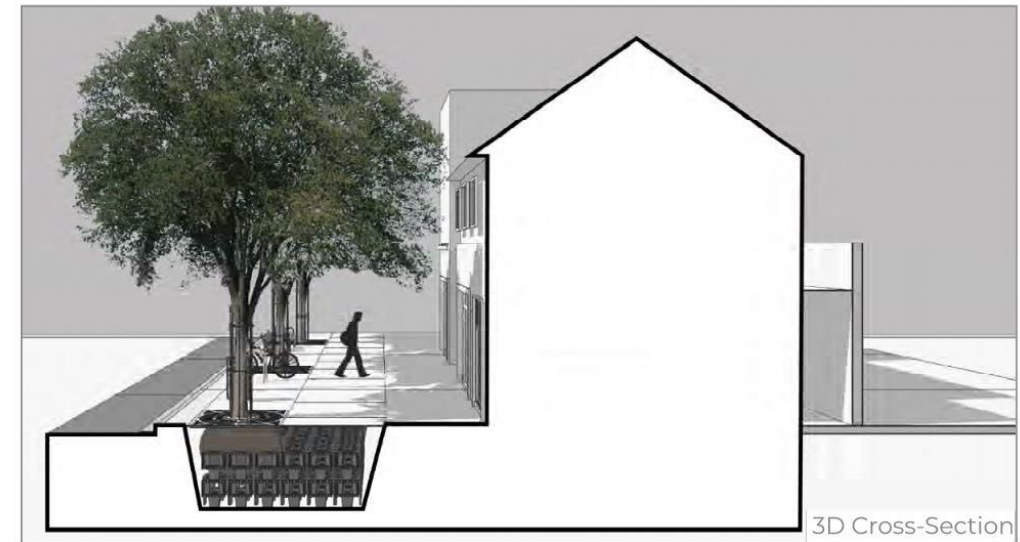
