Due to the Covid-19 pandemic, Ice rentals have changed. The Town of Georgina has only opened The Georgina Ice Palace and will be commencing with third party rentals for available ice. Please read the new requirements, as well as the new Town procedures stated below before requesting an ice rental.

COVID ICE RENTAL REQUIREMENTS

- All users must create and supply a **Return to Play** document for review and approval.
 - A Return to Play document outlines how your program will run with specific references to Covid-19 guidelines and Town procedures. This should include the use of masks, screening, physical distancing, gathering limits etc.
 - All major sport has a Return to Play for their governing body, refer to those as tools for how your sport is modified with current restrictions.
- All users must supply a copy of the **Screening Form** and **Waiver**.
 - All users are responsible for the administration and retention of the Screening form for every participant, every date of play. This will be required for contact tracing purposes, should a participant come in contact with Covid-19
 - All renters are encouraged to have their participants sign a waiver before participating in their program. This would be to emphasize that participants are playing at their own risk and are aware of the risk of contracting Covid-19.
- All permit holders must have valid insurance listing the Town of Georgina as additionally insured with \$2,000,000 liability or obtain insurance from the Town.
- All rental permits must be signed and paid for prior to the permit start date.



TOWN PROCEDURES FOR ICE RENTALS

- Each ice booking will be 50 minutes with the flood occurring for the final 10 minutes.
- A maximum of 50 persons per ice rental
- All signage must be adhered to and permit holder is responsible to ensure all guidelines are met.
- Permit holders must adhere to current Municipal, Provincial & health restrictions in place at the time of booking.
- All permit holders must follow the appropriate or related governing body's return to play guidelines
- Players must be fully dressed prior to arrival, as change room area will be restricted to putting on skates.
- Dressing room capacity is 10 persons. Dressing room doors will always remain open.
- Dressing room showers will be closed.
- All users will arrive and vacate the facility no more than 15 minutes before and after their booked time.
- Your team/group will gather outside and enter as a group, remain together, and exit as a group.
- Ice users will enter the ice surface by using the designated entrance and exit.
- No spectators are permitted at this time. One parent/caregiver is permitted per participant. Parent/caregiver may tie skates at designated seating in the lobby and then proceed to arena seating and will abide by physical distancing markings.
