# Elake Simcoe

More people fish Lake Simcoe than any other inland lake in Ontario! With so many great communities around the lake for anglers to visit, we are grateful that you chose the Town of Georgina as the gateway to our pride and joy.

Our primary goal in this article is to help you maximize your fishing opportunities during your visit by letting you know a little about our favourite lake and the fish that live here.



#### **OPEN WATER FISHING**

**PERCH:** After a long winter there is nothing better than getting out on your favourite lake for some early spring fishing. Thanks to the year-round open perch season we have - that favourite destination for thousands is none other than Lake Simcoe. Out from the shores of Georgina, perch are found just about everywhere. We have both good eaters to harvest in the 8-12 inch range and plenty of those true jumbos (13-15") with some topping two pounds that should be live released! The extraordinary quantity and quality of our perch fishery has been recognized by many visiting Americans with first-hand testimonials as one of the finest perch destinations in all of North America. This is one reason we see so many visitors from nearby Michigan and New York. There are many excellent areas for perch including out from the communities of Virginia, Willow Beach, Pefferlaw, Keswick and Port Bolster. Launching your boat from Keswick's Raynar's Launch or from Sibbald Point Provincial Park will put you in reach of some great perch waters. Later in the year, Pefferlaw River at Quinn's Marina on the south side of Hwy. 48, will get you to the mouth of the river and big fall perch in no time. Many visiting perch anglers stay at Peninsula Resort right at the mouth of the Pefferlaw River.

Finding one or two perch usually means you have found a school, so don't become discouraged if you don't get bit right away. Casting a search spoon such as the small Blue Fox Minnow Spin is a great way to locate a school of perch. Or try a slow troll for perch with a smaller X Rap. Here's a trick that can really pay big dividends: After you connect with one fish, throw a marker

buoy to the spot where the perch hit and drop anchor if you like before you proceed to cast to that area with jigs or even a short lead drop-shot rig.

Many perch experts on Simcoe are forgoing the use of live minnows in favour of productive artificial soft plastics that perfectly mimic minnows and gobies that perch feed on. Remember, if you do use minnows, please buy them locally and don't dump leftover bait back in the lake. These two action items are key to reduce the spread of invasive species and disease.

Our perch are extremely plentiful and great to eat, but in order to sustain a true trophy perch fishery, we ask anglers to release those precious perch over 12-13 inches. This way we can all do our part to conserve this great fishery for future generations.

SPRING SEASON: Not many lakes in Ontario have so many species all opening on the same day: Northern pike, lake trout, whitefish, walleye and cisco all open on the second Saturday in May. The more elusive yet trophy-sized walleye are more of an incidental catch; worthy of a glory-shot and then carefully live released. The lowly brown bullhead on the other hand does not even have a closed season but it's plentiful and can really turn on the same weekend. Hook a 'gob' of worms onto a hook, and fish near bottom for these tasty morsels that are often overlooked by most anglers ... that is, until they find out how much fun they are to catch and how good they are to eat.

Pike: The shallow, weedy areas in York Region's Cook's Bay likely hold more pike than the rest of the lake combined! It's here that the Aurora Bassmasters

club hold their annual Spring Open Pike tournament out of Keswick's popular Boston Pizza plaza. Another productive area that has coughed up some big toothy critters lately is the Virginia basin ... that shallow weedy section between Georgina Island and the mainland in Virginia. Productive pike techniques include trolling or casting large Blue Fox Spinners along weedlines and Rapala X Raps overtop weedbeds. When pike are inactive, make long casts with jigs and soft plastics or try some of the Storm swimbaits near the newly emerging aquatic plants that pike love. This same area has been one of the stocking sites for the Lake Simcoe Muskie Restoration Program, so if any muskie are caught (there is a closed season year round) they need to be released.

**LAKERS AND WHITIES:** After the opener, boats gather out from the Willow Beach and Jackson's Point area for big specimens of either fish that hang around until mid-late June. Their season closes Sept 30th and reopens Jan 1 for ice fishing. Various jigging spoons produce but the Blue Fox Moresilda spoon jigged vertically below the boat in 60-75 feet of water comes highly recommended. Locally made Bad Boyz jigs worked right on bottom are great for whitefish, but perform even better when a small crappie sized tube is added to the single hook. With more whitefish now feeding on gobies be sure to also try the Storm Goby swim bait and work it with little twitches right on bottom. This will mimic the goby behaviour and should pay big dividends.

For deepwater whitie or laker fishing, you are fishing blind if you don't use a high quality sonar to look for the right depth, baitfish and the big fish you're after.

Visitors and residents alike will want to insert the latest Navionics Canada Gold 2XG chip into their sonar's that will give a complete digital map of Lake Simcoe showing depth contours, shoals and other likely fishing spots. With Lowrance's built in GPS, you can also save your Simcoe hot spots and revisit them easily to help increase your odds.

BASS: Saving the best for last ... Simcoe's bass season is the last to open – on the fourth Saturday of June and closes Nov. 30. Recognized as one of Canada's finest smallmouth bass fisheries, this lake is renowned for producing "Personal Bests" for anglers from across southern Ontario and neighbouring US States. Many report that Georgina's southeast portion of the lake is home to hundreds of these monster smallmouths.

Simcoe is also home to the record for the five heaviest bass ever weighed in during a Canadian bass tournament at just shy of 32 pounds. Tournament anglers from across North America know the bass here are huge but thousands of recreational anglers have also heard about the record sized smallmouth Simcoe has to offer so have put Lake Simcoe on their bucket list.

Although the weedier sections of the lake provides good largemouth fishing, smallmouth prefer rocky shorelines, points, drop-offs and around any one of Simcoe's productive islands. Georgina Island, home to the Chippewa's First Nation Community, is a top producer. Rapala X Raps and Shadow Raps are great smallmouth baits here, especially when there's some chop on the water. When conditions are calm and sunny, soft plastics like tube jigs worked on bottom or drop shotted goby-style baits just off



bottom, can be deadly. Be sure to also try the Storm Arashi 360GT Searchbait that so closely resembles the baitfish our bass feed on that it's scary!

This lake has become a true worldclass trophy smallmouth destination thanks in no small part to the conservation minded anglers who voluntarily live release most or all of their catch, especially larger fish over a couple pounds.

A great place to access the lake in York Region for smallmouth is Sibbald Point Provincial Park. Here, families from across the Region and beyond come not only to fish but to boat, picnic, camp, swim or just sunbathe on the clean sandy beach. In 2019, this park will once again host the popular "Learn to Fish" program and is great for campers and newcomers to the sport. Sibbald Point Provincial Park also hosts the Fish Hard Dream Big Event for kids every June and the Perchin for MS event every March.

#### WINTER FISHING

If you enjoyed fishing Simcoe during the open water season, then we welcome you back with open arms to try the great sport of ice fishing here. With several well established ice hut operators in Georgina, it makes it easy for families and others to try this great winter sport. For active, hard core ice anglers, the quality and quantity of fish available, brings them back year after year.

MNRF stocks ~50,000 lake trout and ~140,000 whitefish into the lake each year. Yellow perch are still the most sought after species during the hard water season on Simcoe, simply because of the quality and quantity of perch here.

Whether you are one of the thousands of visiting anglers or a local Georgina resident, you need go no further than out from the shores of one of our lakeside communities, for some tasty Lake Simcoe fish caught through the ice. We have several ice hut operators who cater to the species of your choice and supply you with a nice warm hut and transportation to get way out there.

For more information on Lake Simcoe fishing regulations or purchasing a licence etc, check out: *ontario.ca*. Here you can also log onto the interactive Fish on Line link with Google Maps and learn all about the fish from Lake Simcoe.

Lake Simcoe has some of the cleanest and safest fish to eat in the province. As a general guideline, larger, older fish pose more of a health risk so by releasing them you are not only doing the lake a service,



but yourself as well. For more details on eating Lake Simcoe fish, check out: *ontario.ca* 

For all Lake Simcoe anglers regardless of whether you are a pro or just fish for fun... remember, the future of fishing is in your hands. Please practice selective harvest and catch and release to ensure the great fishing opportunities remain for future generations.






# COMMUNITIES OF COMMUN

he Town of Georgina is comprised of numerous lakeside communities, hamlets and urban centres. It includes Keswick, Orchard Beach, Roches Point, Island Grove, Willow Beach, Franklin Beach, Jackson's Point, Sutton, Baldwin, Brown Hill, Udora, Port Bolster, Pefferlaw, Virginia, Egypt, Vachell, Cedarbrae and Duclos Point. With an anticipated population of 71,000 by the year 2031, Georgina provides the opportunity for lakeside

living with a range of urban amenities.

Named by Governor John Graves Simcoe in honour of



Roches Point Anglican Church

King George III, the area was surveyed in 1817 and settlement began in 1819. The first patents were issued to Captain William

Bourchier, R.N., who, in 1839, built his regency home known as the "Briars." Drawn to this area by rich agricultural land, a scenic pineforested shoreline and close proximity to York (now Toronto), Georgina soon became home to numerous settlers, many of whom have family names that are still prominent in the Town.

#### **KESWICK**

Keswick, the largest of Georgina's urban communities, offers an attractive combination of urban services and rural charm. The community has been the site of extensive growth over the past 25 years. New residential development has led to a significant amount of commercial growth that provides shopping and service opportunities for residents and visitors.

One of the most beautiful and historic buildings in the area is the Anglican Church in Roches Point, which was built in 1863. The Rev. Walter Stennet M.A., retired principal of Upper Canada College, designed the building in a primitive Gothic

style reminiscent of an English country church and was responsible for most of the labour. The graveyard is full of historic interest as it contains the remains of Georgina's early settlers.

The Recreation Outdoor Campus (The ROC), provides a variety of adventure sports, baseball diamonds and soccer pitches for residents and tournament organizers. Open year round, it offers great outdoor activities from rock climbing, rope courses and zip lines to tobogganing, tubing and skiing.

Golfers have an excellent full-service, nine-hole golf course available in Orchard Beach and a private course in Eastbourne. Beachfront parks at Willow Beach and North Gwillimbury Park provide playgrounds and picnic facilities and year-round access to Lake Simcoe.

Whether you're boating, fishing or sailboarding, Keswick boasts several full service marinas, located on the shoreline from south Keswick to Island Grove. During the winter, the local marinas offer ice fishing supplies as well as service and sales of winter recreation vehicles. Ice fishing and ice sailing on the lake is very popular for those who have their own equipment or contact a local hut operator and enjoy a heated hut with all supplies provided for your fishing excursion.

The waters off Jackson's Point are ideal for divers who want to see remnants of the pre-war Metropolitan Radial Railway (formally Grand Trunk Rail). It brought hundreds of tourists from the noise of the city through quiet fields to the placid cool waters of Lake Simcoe at Jackson's Point. Further east along Hedge Road at the entrance to Sibbald Point Provincial Park is St. George's Church and the burial site of one of Canada's foremost authors - Stephen Butler Leacock. Although he won worldwide acclaim with extensive writings on political science, economics and history, he is best known for his "Sunshine Sketches of a Little Town," "Arcadian Adventures with the Idle Rich" and "Literary Lapses." the first works to be essentially Canadian in character and spirit. Buried in the same churchyard is Mazo de la Roche, author of "Jalna,"

Sibbald Point Provincial Park is one of southern Ontario's most popular parks, drawing thousands of pleasure seekers each year for summer camping, picnicking, swimming and boating, and for winter activities such as cross-country skiing and ice fishing. Located in the provincial park is Eildon Hall, a memorial museum that was once the home of Lieutenant-Colonel William Sibbald and his wife, Susan.

The most historic building in the area is the Briars. Originally built in 1840 by Cpt. William Bourchier, R.N., and Frank Sibbald, it was transformed into a resort by his great nephew, Jack Sibbald after the First World War and into an inn in 1977 by his son John and his wife Barbara Sibbald. Today, an overnight stay at the Briars provides you with access to the premier 18-hole Briars Golf Course.

De La Salle Park and Willow Beach Conservation Area are operated by the Town of Georgina and offer excellent swimming, picnic facilities and parking.

Golfers have a choice of two nine-hole courses, one near De La Salle Park and the other at Willow Beach. The latter also offers a driving range and a mini putt course.

#### SUTTON

Captain William Bourchier, R.N., a
Scotsman, returned from the navy after
the War of 1812 and took up grants of
land with his younger brother, James,
in what is now Sutton. Eventually, they
were to become responsible for the
development of Bourchier's Mill, later
Sutton. The village has developed to the
point where it now runs into Jackson's
Point to the north and the hamlet of
Virginia to the east. Virginia is home to
the ferry service that provides vehicular
and pedestrian transportation to Georgina
Island.


The Manor House in Sutton and the Briars in Jackson's Point, both built by the Bourchier family, are now designated heritage sites.

The Sutton Fair and Horse Show, is one of the oldest fairs in Ontario and will celebrate 164 years this summer. The fair offers a tractor pull, demo derby, live music, midway, rides and more.

Sutton is blessed with a large fairground, a curling arena, the Sutton Arena, an indoor swimming pool, and outdoor nature. Summer or winter, there is always plenty to do.

High Street and Dalton Road provide a range of commercial and service commercial to service the needs of the travelling public and residents.

#### **PEFFERLAW**

The village of Pefferlaw is concentrated to the south of Hwy. 48 along the Pefferlaw River. It extends from Virginia to Port Bolster and includes Duclos Point, McRae Beach, Morning Glory and Holmes Point.

The village owes its founding to the river flowing through it, which bears its name. The Pefferlaw River afforded an excellent site for a mill and, circa 1830, Captain Wm. Johnson, R.N. retired, built a sawmill, gristmill and woollen mill after similar efforts in Baldwin had failed. The site of the old mill is now a riverside park enjoyed by all.

The village has a downtown business district offering grocery stores, refreshments, banking services, restaurants, a library, automotive repair and personal services.

The Pefferlaw River offers several marinas, which offer a variety of services for boaters and snowmobilers. The river and Lake Simcoe also provide access points to the lake. The Town owned beachfront, Holmes Point, provides a beautiful shallow sandy beachfront for all to enjoy. At the mouth of the river is the popular Peninsula Motel that provides year round access to a beautiful private park facility and beachfront. The Pines of Georgina Golf Course on Hwy. 48 is a popular 18-hole course complete with club facilities, a lounge and restaurant.

#### **BAI DWIN**

Located south of Sutton and just east of Keswick, the hamlet of Baldwin is home to many hobby and equestrian farms.

The main landmark in Baldwin is the gristmill on the Black River. The first mill was built in the early 1800s, but both it and its replacement burned down. The current structure was brought from Keswick piece by piece and began operation in 1883.

Many of the area's original wood and cobblestone structures are still standing. The area's businesses and amenities include a motel, antique stores, 18-hole golf course, restaurant and convenience store, located on Hwy. 48 north of Ravenshoe Road.


Baldwin is also home to the Baldwin Airport, which offers skydiving through the Parachute School of Toronto Limited.

#### **UDORA**

The hamlet of Udora is located in the southeast of Georgina and is situated on the Pefferlaw River which is the focal point of a large private camp called Jõekääru, meaning river bend in English. The camp was purchased by the Independent Toronto Estonian Women's Association in the 1950s and continues to operate today.

#### PORT BOLSTER

The hamlet of Port Bolster is often considered an extension of Pefferlaw. Its main street is Durham Road 23 (also known as Lake Ridge Road) and offers visitors unique shops and quaint restaurants. Port Bolster is very popular for its fishing, both in summer and winter and you can find a handful of ice hut operators to help you experience the lake.


# Jeorgina








With 582 campsites and a 400-metre stretch of sandy beach on Lake Simcoe, Sibbald Point Provincial Park is truly a jewel of Georgina. While visiting the picturesque park, you can also explore the historic Eildon Hall Museum.

For 130 years before Sibbald Point became a park, Eildon Hall was home of the Sibbald family. One of the oldest structures in the area, this interesting house was the first Canadian residence of Susan Mein Sibbald (1783-1866), a gentlewoman pioneer whose memoirs were published posthumously in 1926. Initially a small Regency style cottage, it was begun in 1830 by William Kingdom Rains, an early settler, and acquired around 1835 by Susan Sibbald. Named Eildon Hall after her family home in Scotland, it was expanded and transformed into an extensive rural manor. The estate remained in the Sibbald family until 1952. Eildon Hall Museum displays 19th century artefacts and furniture. For more information on hours of operation visit ontarioparks.com.

Officially opened on Thanksgiving Day 1975 by Chief of the Chippewas of Georgina Island, Lorenzo Big Canoe, the Georgina Pioneer Village & Archives is a veritable heritage showcase.

Located near the south shore of beautiful Lake Simcoe, this 10-acre site is home to numerous buildings that interpret the history of Georgina between 1850 and 1920, including a one-room schoolhouse, a general store, a train station, a blacksmith shop, an apothecary and a backwoods log house.

The Pioneer Village also houses an extensive archival collection comprised of records created by the councils of the former townships of Georgina and North Gwillimbury, as well as the Village of Sutton. In addition, the Archives contain a number of personal family documents, including land records, photographs, scrapbooks, bibles and related ephemera.
