

Georgina Leisure Pool

Thank you for choosing the Georgina Leisure Pool. This fully accessible aquatic facility hosts three swimming pools including a lap, leisure and therapy pool along with a slide. Recreational drop-in programs, swim lessons, aquatic leadership, registered programs and party rentals are available.

The aquatic staff are committed to creating a safe and enjoyable atmosphere. Please recognize the pool rules and assist the staff with their delivery. The Georgina Leisure Pool staff reserves the right to refuse admittance into the pool if capacity has been reached or otherwise deemed necessary for the health, welfare and safety of the patrons.

FACILITY RULES/INFORMATION

- Admission policy is strictly enforced.
- General admittance to the pool is for the scheduled swim time only. Re-admittance to another swim time the same day will not be permitted.
- The Town of Georgina is not responsible for lost or stolen articles.
- Smoking is not permitted anywhere in the facilities, or on the outside grounds of the facility.
- Loitering will not be permitted on the pool grounds or within any of its facilities. Management reserves the right to revoke or refuse admittance due to inappropriate conduct.
- No person with communicable diseases or open sores on his or her body shall enter the pool.
- No person shall bring a glass container onto the deck or into the pool.
- No person shall pollute the water in the pool in any manner and spitting, spouting and blowing the nose in the pool or on the deck are prohibited.
- No person shall engage in boisterous play in or about the pool.
- Patrons shall take a shower using soap and warm water before entering or re-entering the deck and pool area.
- No street wear is to be worn on the pool deck at any time.
- Children who are not toilet trained must wear plastic pants over a diaper OR a pair of "Little Swimmers" disposable swim pants.
- Alcohol and drugs are strictly prohibited.
- The Town of Georgina strictly prohibits the use of cell phones or cameras in change room areas. Cameras are permitted during scheduled swimming lessons only.
- The maximum number of bathers at any time is 144 people. All patrons on deck must have paid admission.

HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICIES

- The Town of Georgina assumes no liability for injuries or damages arising from the results of participation unless due to willful or gross negligence on the part of The Town of Georgina. Due to the strenuous nature of some activities, the participant is advised to consult his/her physician concerning fitness to participate. All activities present certain inherent risks and hazards which the participant assumes.
- Any person having a skin disease, sore or inflamed eyes, cold, nasal or ear discharge, communicable disease, or who is wearing any kind of bandage will not be permitted in the pool.
- An adult or child who is experiencing even a mild case of diarrhea may not use the pool.

CHANGE ROOMS/LOCKERS

- Please remove outdoor shoes at entrance to change rooms.
- Children 6 years of age and under are permitted in either change areas with a guardian of the opposite gender.
- Children 7 years of age and older must utilize the appropriate change area or Accessible/ Family change area when accompanied by an adult or guardian.
- Food or beverages are not permitted in change rooms or on the pool deck.
- Personal use lockers are available for your convenience.
- Patrons are welcome to supply their own lock they are also available for purchase at reception, provided that it is removed at the end of each visit.
- The Corporation of the Town of Georgina is not responsible for lost or stolen articles. It is strongly recommended that any articles considered to be of value be locked up or left at home.

BEACH POOL

- The Beach Pool capacity is 44 persons at one time.
- The Beach Pool is designed for children 8 years of age and under. They must be accompanied by an adult/guardian 16 years of age or older. Admission Policy will be enforced.
- Adults or guardians must be in a bathing suit, in the water, and within arm's reach of their children at all times.
- The temperature is maintained between 90 and 94 degrees Fahrenheit.

LAP POOL

- The Lap Pool capacity is 75 persons at one time.
- The temperature is maintained between 80 and 86 degrees Fahrenheit.
- The Lap Pool is 75' (25m) in length by 24' (8m) wide. The depth is 3' (1m) in the shallow area and 10'(3m) in the deep area.
- All swimmers will be subject to a screening before entering the deep area. The criteria one must complete in order to be allowed to swim in the deep area of the pool is: swim two widths of the lap pool comfortably and support their body at the surface for at least 1 minute (without assistance or difficulty).
- Toys and mats are permitted in the shallow end of the only.
- Diving is only permitted along the deep end wall.
- Lanes will be designated for slow, medium and fast swimmers, to assist with smooth traffic flow. Swimmers are asked to swim in the lanes in a continuous circle fashion, in a counter-clockwise direction.

THERAPY POOL/WATER SLIDE

- The Therapy Pool capacity is 25 persons at one time, while the slide is not operational. When the slide is operational no patrons are permitted in the Therapy Pool.
- The Therapy pool is fully accessible. It is equipped with a hydraulic chair lift.
- The temperature is maintained between 90 and 94 degrees Fahrenheit.
- The 2 story Water Slide enters into the Therapy Pool, the slide is 90 feet in length. The slide operates during Public Swim times, except where noted otherwise.
- Riders must be 48" or taller to use the slide.
- Riders are permitted on the slide one at a time; they must enter the slide seated and must be in a sitting position or lying flat on their back, enter the Therapy Pool feet first.
- When riding the slide, hands must remain inside the channel at all times.
- Those who are frightened to go down the slide will be escorted back down the stairs by the slide attendant.
- Toys or loose objects are not permitted to go down the slide with any person.
- The lineup for the slide will be located at the bottom of the stairs. The slide attendant will signal each patron (one at a time) when it is time to come up the stairs.
- Riders must exit the pool immediately after each ride.
- Goggles and glasses are prohibited when using the slide.
