




Zone 2 De La Salle Park – You wanted......




- Notices at the beach re: water quality
- Buoys to keep boats away from the swimming area
- Connect north and south lots with a driveway so people don't have to go out to the adjacent roads
- Designate the north lot for residents, and more parking on Jericho lands
- A bigger strategy for parking that includes parking off site with shuttle
- Better management of parking
- Add an education centre
- Upgrade washrooms,
- Storage racks for canoes/kayaks
- Make sure we can accommodate year round use: ice fishing and snow machines

Full spectrum of opinion on new commercial/retail/food at De La Salle




Zone 2 De La Salle Park – Emerging Concept



Seasonal Road Closures at Parks

"Our parks are for people, not cars. For more than a century, cars have turned parts of the world's most iconic parks into highways. Today, we take them back. We are prioritizing the safety and the health of the millions of parents, children and visitors who flock to Central Park."

Aurora - Wells Street closed to traffic at the Farmer's Market every weekend (and every day at lunch when the school was in use).

Toronto - High Park is closed to traffic on weekends, proposal to close the main loop road to cars year round

Toronto - Major Weekend Road Closures began in mid-May and were in place for 25 consecutive weekends through the end of October. The program was extended twice — into September and again through October... Included Lakeshore Boulevard.

Seasonal Closure


- Closed to traffic July –
 August
- Temporary turnaround at either end of park
- Paved roadway used as pedestrian promenade
- Park is connected to the beach
- Re-route traffic to Metro Road in summer
- Lake Drive for local access only
- Re-open after Labour Day



Manage Capacity at the beach - Example

- Added Gate Control
- New Charge for admission:
 - \$10 season pass (permanent & seasonal residents)
 - \$5 per visit for visitors
- New Parking Meters on streets within 500m of park
- Permit system for residents who can't park on their property (confirmed on a case-by-case basis)
- New rules: No tents, umbrellas only
