## JACKSON'S POINT HARBOURFRONT REDEVELOPMENT PLAN

### How to get involved

1. The Town will be holding **one-on-one interviews** with anyone who wishes to speak with the consultants on Monday, May 29<sup>th</sup> at the Ramada (49 Lorne St, Jacksons Point, ON L0E 1L0). To book a 20-minute interview with the consultant anytime between 9:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. please email [jacksonspoint@planpart.ca](mailto:jacksonspoint@planpart.ca). Please be sure to bring your ideas on the possibilities for the Jackson's Point Harbourfront.

As an alternative, the consultants have also offered to hold interviews in Toronto at 1255 Bay Street, Suite 500 if that's more convenient for you - Tuesday, May 30<sup>th</sup> from 4:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. Please email [jacksonspoint@planpart.ca](mailto:jacksonspoint@planpart.ca) to arrange a 20-minute interview.

2. Participate in the **public design charrette** to be held on Thursday June 8<sup>th</sup> and Saturday June 10<sup>th</sup> at the Ramada, Jackson's Point. You can participate in several ways:

#### **Thursday, June 8<sup>th</sup>:**

Join the **workshop** at either 4:00 p.m. or 7:00 p.m. for a presentation on our understanding of the study area's site conditions and what we've heard so far from the community. This presentation will be followed by a table group discussion to formulate an overarching vision statement for the study area and fundamental design principles that will help shape the design options to be developed on June 10<sup>th</sup>.

Meet members of the team on site at 1:00 p.m. for a **walkshop** where the team will talk about how you use the study areas site now and have used it in the past and possibilities for the future.

#### **Saturday June 10<sup>th</sup>:**

Register to participate in one of the **design sessions** at either 10:00 a.m. or 1:00 p.m. During the design session, you will join a design team and work alongside others at your table with a designer to prepare a concept for the site. Each concept will explore opportunities for the park, recreation facilities,

  - **Saturday July 22:** Festival on High Street – Sutton. Our Georgina tent will be set up from 10 a.m. – 1 p.m.
  - **Saturday July 22:** Movie in the Jackson's Point Parkette. Our Georgina tent will be set up 7:30 p.m. – 9 p.m.
4. Provide your comments on the design concepts by completing a brief [Design Options Review Survey](#). If you would like to provide your input, but are unable to attend one of the Roving sessions or complete the online survey, please let us know and we can work something out to obtain your feedback.
5. Attend a **public workshop** to be held **August 10, 2017** at the Ramada Hotel at either 3 p.m. or 6:30 p.m. to review and provide feedback of the results of the evaluation of the concepts and the emerging preferred plan.
6. Attend the **Council meeting** on **September 19, 2017** at 7 p.m. for a presentation on the Jackson's Point Harbourfront Redevelopment Plan.
7. Monitor the Town of Georgina's website, Facebook page and twitter for updates on the project.
