



Town of Georgina Noise By-law

Any alleged noise infraction can be reported to the Town of Georgina Municipal Law Enforcement Division during regular business hours, Monday to Friday 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., by calling 905-476-4301, ext 2279.

After hours and on weekends, residents can call ext 2281 and leave a voicemail. If there is an on-duty officer available, they will return the call. At different times of the year, Municipal Law Enforcement officers work different shifts, but each day is unique and officers are sometimes not available at different times of the day.

Alternatively, if the resident does not receive a call back and the matter is urgent, they can report the disturbance to York Regional Police.

It is understood that York Regional Police prioritize calls and if they cannot attend the property, the resident should be informed they can follow up with the Municipal Law Enforcement Division during regular business hours. The division has the ability to address these matters after the fact and may lay charges.

The Town of Georgina Noise By-law regulates the following activities:

- Noise from off-road vehicles
- Unusual noise from motor vehicles such as squealing of tires, an ineffective exhaust pipe or banging and squeaking
- Noise from any combustion engine, pneumatic device or construction equipment without effective exhaust or muffling device
- Unusually loud heating, air conditioning or swimming pool filtering equipment
- Detonation of any fireworks outside permitted dates
- Idling of vehicles longer than five minutes
- Loud music or any amplified sound
- Yelling, shouting, hooting, whistling or singing
- Loading, unloading or otherwise handling any products
- Use of construction equipment
- Operation of domestic tools
