



## Jackson's Point Harbourfront Redevelopment Plan

The Town of Georgina has initiated a study that will result in the preparation of the Jackson's Point Harbourfront Redevelopment Plan. This study area includes the former Bonnie Boats site, Malone Wharf, Bonnie Park, unopened Bonnie Boulevard road allowance, site of the Ramada Hotel and the water lots that accompany these properties as indicated on the following page.

### **Summary of Project**

Town staff, with technical experts led by consulting firm The Planning Partnership will be responsible for the development of the Jackson's Point Harbourfront Redevelopment Plan. The preparation of the Redevelopment Plan will evolve through extensive engagement with the residential and business community, Town Council and external agencies. The Plan will be based on the key principles as set out in the Sutton/Jackson's Point Secondary Plan.

### **Provide Your Input and Comments**

The public will be consulted throughout the entire process. The opportunities for input are provided below.

1. The Town will be holding **one-on-one interviews** with anyone who wishes to speak with the consultants on **Monday, May 29<sup>th</sup>** at the Ramada located at 49 Lorne St, Jackson's Point between 9:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.

2. Participate in the **public design charrette/workshop** to be held on **Thursday, June 8<sup>th</sup>** and **Saturday, June 10<sup>th</sup>** at the Ramada, Jackson's Point.

Meet at the harbour at 1:00 p.m. for a **walkshop** where the team will talk and walk learning from residents about how the area is currently used and opportunities for future use.

Join the **workshop** at either 4:00 p.m. or 7:00 p.m. for a presentation on our understanding of the study area's site conditions and what we've heard so far from the community. This presentation will be followed by a discussion to formulate an overarching vision statement for the study area and fundamental design principles that will help shape the design options to be developed on June 10<sup>th</sup>

During the design session, you will join a design team and work alongside others at your table with a designer to prepare a concept for the site. Each concept will explore opportunities for the park, recreation facilities, buildings, public access, boating, natural features, etc. At the conclusion of both design sessions, the team will have many concepts for all to consider.
