





#### Lake Simcoe Protection Plan

• To protect, improve or restore the elements that contribute to the ecological health of the *Lake Simcoe watershed*, including, water quality, hydrology, key natural heritage features and their functions, and key hydrologic features and their functions.

#### Growth Management

- To plan for the Town to grow to a population of about 70,300 by 2031.
- To plan for one new job opportunity for every two new residents by 2013.

#### Rural and Agricultural Areas

- To maintain the open landscape character of rural and agricultural areas.
- To provide opportunities to diversify the rural economy by supporting agriculture and agriculturally related goods and products.

- Establish a Greenlands System that implements the Greenbelt Plan and Regional Official Plan
  - Also reflect the required Study Areas around Key Natural Heritage features and Linkages between features
- Create a single Environmental Protection designation that consists of;
  - Key Natural Heritage features
  - Key Hydrologic features
  - Associated vegetative buffers
- Key Hydrologic Features Separate Schedule
- Source Water Protection Areas Separate Schedule





#### **Growth Management**

Year	Population	Employment
2006	44,600	8,000
2016	52,800	11,000
2021	57,900	13,900
2026	63,900	17,400
2031	70,300	21,200

- Population and Employment Growth directed primarily to the Urban Settlement Areas
- Conversion of Employment Lands to require comprehensive review
- Municipal approval for all Settlement Areas expansions

#### **Settlement Areas**

- Lakeshore Residential Areas to be identified as 'built up' areas but not settlement areas – limited growth, more environmental protection
- Hamlet Open House sessions held in January 2014
  - Some support for minor infill and minor rounding out in some communities
  - Specific policies for Virginia to recognize expansive land area but limited development potential
  - Limited infill development subject to sustainable servicing
- Few changes required to policies or mapping

- Identify area south of Cook Bay as a Special Agricultural Area and recognize flood hazard





### Healthy Communities and Sustainability

- Housing
  - Include target for affordable housing
  - General policies for Special Needs Housing
- Recreation and Open Space
  - Reflect Trails and Active Transportation Master Plan Study
- Heritage Conservation and Archeological Preservation
  - Include policies on First Nation consultation
  - Detailed policies on required studies
- Community Design
  - Refer to low impact design, light trespass and minimizing climate change
- Sustainability
  - To be considered in all decisions regarding land use and public works


