PUBLIC SKATING RULES OF CONDUCT

- ▶ NO LOITERING
- ▶ NO FOOD OR DRINK ON THE ICE SURFACE
- ▶ NO TAG/HORSEPLAY/GAMES/THROWING SNOW
- ▶ NO SKATING BACK WARDS
- ▶ NO FIGURE SKATING MANOEUVRES
- ▶ NO ERRATIC/EXCESSIVE SPEED SKATING
- ▶ NO SKATING AIDS
- ▶ NO BALLS, PUCKS, CHAIRS, PYLONS, STROLLERS, STICKS OR ANY OTHER ITEM WHICH MAY INTERFERE WITH THE SAFETY OF ANY SKATER WHILE ON THE ICE SURFACE
 - ▶ NO HEADSETS, CELL PHONES OR HANDHELD ELECTRONIC DEVICES ARE TO BE USED WHILE ON THE ICE.
 - ▶ NO CARRYING OF CHILDREN IS TO BE PERMITTED
 - ▶ NO SITTING ON THE BOARDS
 - ▶ SKATE WITH THE DIRECTION OF ALL SKATERS
 - ▶ CONDUCT YOURSELF APPROPRIATELY AT ALL TIMES
 - ▶ LISTEN AND ADHERE TO THE SKATE PATROL AT ALL TIMES
 - ▶ ALL PARTICIPANTS MUST BE WEARING SKATES WHILE ON THE ICE SURFACE
 - ▶ CONSIDER THE USE OF A HELMET AS THEY ARE STRONGLY RECOMMENDED
 - ▶ PROMPTLY LEAVE AND STAY OFF THE ICE DURING INTERMISSION AND AT THE CONCLUSION OF A PROGRAM
 - ▶ STAY OFF THE ICE UNTIL THE RE SURFACING IS FINISHED AND THE BACK GATE IS CLOSED

***FAILURE TO FOLLOW THE RULES WILL RESULT IN
YOUR REMOVAL FROM THE PROGRAM***
