Requirements for restaurants in the Red Zone

This is a limited summary of requirements for restaurants. Also refer to the general requirements for all businesses. It is the responsibility of the business owner to stay up-to-date with the provincial regulations.

- 1. Face masks must be worn by all patrons and staff (except those who are exempt, which includes those eating/drinking).
- 2. Servers must wear masks and eye protection if providing services within two metres of someone not wearing a mask without Plexiglas between server and customer.
- 3. May only provide product by take out, drive-through, or delivery between 10 p.m. and 5 a.m.
- 4. Customers must be seated at all time unless exempt.
- 5. Tables must be separated by two metres or Plexiglas.
- 6. Must record names of members of public entering facility and their contact information.
- 7. Alcohol may only be sold between 9 a.m. and 9 p.m.
- 8. Capacity cannot exceed 10 diners.
- 9. Capacity at each table cannot exceed four diners.
- 10. Music must not be louder than normal conversation.
- 11. People may not dance, sing, or perform.
- 12. Outdoor dining in a tent or tarp structure must have two full walls open.
