## **Application and Permit Refunds**

Please refer to Section 16 of <u>Building By-law 2015-0150</u> for the full context of building permit refunds.

## **Building Permits**

- 1. All requests to cancel a building permit application or issued building permit must be submitted in writing to the Town of Georgina's Chief Building Official.
- 2. The following summarizes the applicable refunds that may be applied:
  - Up to 90% of the paid permit fee is refundable if administrative functions only have been performed;
  - Up to 80% of the paid permit fee is refundable if zoning/applicable law review only has commenced;
  - Up to 60% of the paid permit fee is refundable if zoning/applicable law and building code examination functions have commenced;
  - An additional 5% of the paid permit fee is retained by the Town for each site visit that occurs.
- 3. A pre-permit surcharge that was charged for work commencing prior to obtaining a permit is not refundable.
- 4. Generally, no permit fees are refundable for a building permit that has been issued for 6 months or more.
- 5. Any refunded fee or deposit will only be returned to the person identified on the receipt.
- 6. No permit fee refund shall be made where the calculated refund is less than the minimum fee.

## Site Alteration Permits
