

## **Requirements for personal care services in Modified Step 2**

This is a limited summary of requirements for personal care services. Also refer to the general requirements for all businesses. It is the responsibility of the business owner to stay up-to-date with the provincial regulations.

1. Persons who provide personal care services in the business must wear appropriate personal protective equipment.
2. No personal care services that require the removal of a mask may be provided.
3. No member of the public may be permitted to enter the premises except by appointment.
4. The capacity limit must be posted in a conspicuous location visible to the public.
5. Music must not be played at a decibel level that exceeds the level at which normal conversation is possible.
6. Steam rooms and saunas must be closed.
7. Oxygen bars must be closed.
8. Individuals must be actively screened in accordance with the advice, recommendations and instructions of the Office of the Chief Medical Officer of Health before they enter the indoor premises of the establishment.
