Requirements for retail stores during shutdown

This is a limited summary of requirements for retail stores. Refer also to the general requirements for all businesses. It is the responsibility of the business owner to stay up-to-date with the provincial regulations.

- 1. Customer capacity limit must be posted at each entrance.
- 2. Grocery stores, convenience stores, and pharmacies may operate up to 50 per cent of store capacity
- 3. All other retail may operate at 25 per cent of store capacity.
- 4. Business must monitor capacity limit.
- 5. Music must not be louder than normal conversation.
